

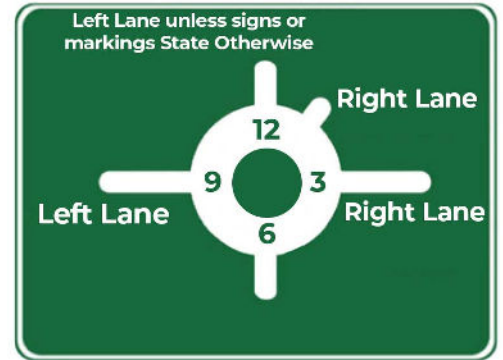

Lane Procedure

Lane discipline on roundabouts

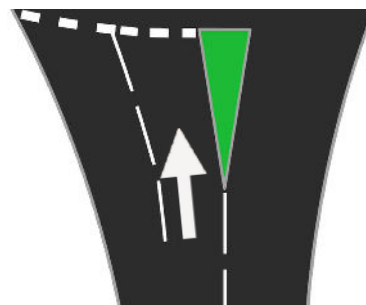
As a general rule if turning left or going straight ahead use the left hand lane, unless the road markings say otherwise.

If the exit displayed on the sign is past 12 o'clock then consider it to be a right turn and therefore you would use the right hand lane.

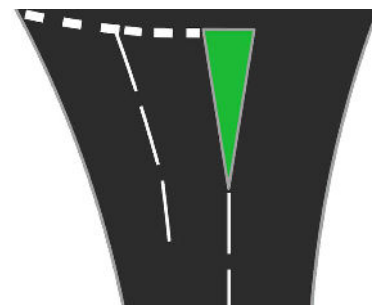


Look where your exit is located on the sign

Look for road markings



Right hand lane
for ahead



Left hand lane
for ahead

Turning Left: Signal and keep in the left lane

Turning Right: Signal right, use the right hand lane, as you pass the exit before your intended exit signal left and move over to the left hand lane to exit the roundabout

Road Ahead: if there are no markings stating otherwise, approach in the left hand lane without a signal, as you pass the exit before your intended exit signal left and move over to the left lane to exit the roundabout.

Always: check the relevant mirrors before signalling or moving lanes.
